14 – 15 February 2022 | Warrnambool Golf Club

This event honours Mrs Marjorie Robinson, a former Women's Captain, President, Secretary, and Life Member of the Warrnambool Golf Club. Marjorie was a popular member, playing in the 1920's and competing at Pennant and Country Championship level. She was Club Champion in 1943 and 1949 and was widely respected for her knowledge of rules and etiquette, her readiness to help beginners, her fairness and her approachable manner.

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

Competition Structure – Day 1

- Four-Ball Stableford
- Teams of 2
- Players can be from different clubs

Competition Structure – Day 1

- Individual Stableford
- Teams of 4
- Players must be from same club

Substitutions

Subject to the approval of the Organising Committee, following entry into the competition, it is permissible to substitute an alternative player for a nominated player who is unable to compete due to illness, injury or any other justifiable reason. The substitute player must be eligible to compete in accordance with the conditions of the competition.

1. ELIGIBILITY

Eligible players are female amateur golfers whose Golf Australia Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 45.4 strokes (women).

Warrnambool Golf Club Members - Day 1

- Warrnambool home members are only eligible to enter a team with a player from a visiting club.
- Warrnambool home members are not eligible to enter a team with another player from Warrnambool. If field capacity is not reached before 31 January 2022, two Warrnambool members will be eligible to enter as a pair on a first come first serve basis.

Warrnambool Golf Club Members - Day 2

- Warrnambool will reserve two teams for its members, with players entering a ballot for draw prior to the event.

All competitors as part of their condition of entry into this event, will be required to produce proof of double Covid-19 vaccination at time of registration.

2. ENTRIES

- All entries shall only be made online via the registration link at www.warrnamboolgolf.com.au/events
- Entries will only be accepted once registration has been submitted and payment of entry fee has been approved.
- WGC shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.

- The draws for the competition will be sent to players and available at www.warrnamboolgolf.com.au/events approximately one week prior to the event.
- Entries open on 12 November 2021 and close on Friday, 4 February 2022, or when field capacity is reached.
- A maximum of 60 teams of 2 will be accepted on Day 1
- A maximum of 30 teams of 4 will be accepted on Day 2 (including a maximum of 2 Warrnambool teams)
- WGC shall have the right to withdraw any person from the event at any time for COVID-19 related circumstances.

3. TROPHIES

Day 1 – Four-Ball Stableford (18-Hole)

- Winning Pair (Division A & B)
- Runner Up Pair (Division A & B)
- NTP (9th, 13th & 15th) for each division

Day 2 – Individual Stableford and Bowl (18-Hole)

- Winning team - Marjorie Robinson Bowl (Overall best combined team score)
- Individual Winner (Division A, B & C)
- Individual Runner Up (Division A, B & C)
- NTP (9th, 13th & 15th) for each division

In the event of a tie for the Bowl and/or all trophies in any division, all positions/winners shall be decided by the system of count-back as specified by Golf Australia.

4. ORGANISING COMMITTEE

- The Organising Committee shall consist of WGC representatives as appointed by the Club's Match Committee
- The Organising Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the terms
- Protests must be made to the Organising Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each competition day.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to accept additional post entries, subject to availability, for any competition that has not reached a full field capacity.

5. REFUND POLICY

- Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received 10 days prior to the date of competition.
- To be eligible for a refund after this time, players must provide supporting documents



regarding their withdrawal from the event (e.g. medical certificate).

6. MOTORISED CARTS

- Competitors are permitted to ride in or on a motorised vehicle during this event.
- Carts must be requested at time of registration.
- Every effort is made to accommodate cart requests. However, please note that the number of carts is limited, therefore it may be necessary for players to share a cart.
- Preference will be given to those players with a medical certificate.
- It should be noted that the hire of carts is at the competitor's own expense. Cart hire is \$45 per cart per day.

7. RULES OF GOLF & LOCAL RULES

- The competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any Local Rules in force on the day of play. If a dispute arises at any point, it shall be decided by the Match Committee in charge of the Competition, whose decision shall be final.
- The Organising Committee will determine any variation in the conditions should they deem it necessary.

8. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

The use of distance measuring devices is permitted, but is restricted to devices that measure distance only.

9. CODE OF CONDUCT

10. ALCOHOL & SMOKE-FREE POLICY

11. COMPETITION RESULTS & CLOSE

When the Marjorie Robinson Bowl and associated trophies are presented to the winner/s, the results of the competition are officially announced, and the competition is closed.

12. DATABASE OF COMPETITORS' DETAILS

- The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by WGC and may be utilised by WGC or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means.
- From time-to-time, players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the WGC e-newsletter,

or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of this event, or information about events conducted by WGC approved bodies.

- Upon receipt by WGC of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

13. IMAGES

- WGC may arrange for promotion of the event for radio, internet and television broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of the event.
- By this application, the player consents to the use by WGC, or persons authorised by the club, of their name, likeness, voice and references to them and photographs and other images of them and their play connected with their appearance in the event, or any portion(s) thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of the event.
- Cooperation of players with authorised representatives of the media is required, provided that no pre-event activities outside of those activities which are part of the event will be required and provided that the player is not unreasonably interfered with during play.
